
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Day/Time	Activities
Sunday	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Drive from Phoenix to Sedona. Hike Bell Rock, shop downtown, and check out Tlaquepaque Arts & Shopping Village. (\$5 Red Rocks Pass)
Monday	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Visit the Grand Canyon (\$35). Walk the rim and see the Desert View Tower.
Tuesday	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Drive to Zion (\$35). Hike a quick trail like Watchman Trail or with a full day, The Narrows.
Wednesday	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sand board at Coral Pink Sand Dunes State Park and find Bigfoot (\$25 FCFS)
Thursday	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Antelope Canyon with Taadidiin Tours (\$50)• Horseshoe Bend (\$10)• Glen Canyon Dam and Carl Hayden Visitor Center
Friday	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Slide Rock State Park if you have time and hang out in Sedona again (\$24)• Drive back to Phoenix.

Sunday	- 2 hrs from Phoenix to Sedona
Monday	- 2 hrs to the Grand Canyon from Sedona

Wednesday	- 30 min from Kanab to Coral Pink Sand Dunes State Park. 1 hr 16 min from Kanab to Page.
Thursday	- 10 min from Page to Horseshoe Bend. 15 min from Page to Antelope Canyon tours. 2 hr 13 from Page to Flagstaff.
Friday	- 50 min from Flagstaff to Sedona



Day	Campground/Hotel Details
Sunday	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Cave Spring Campground</u> in Sedona. Pay extra for showers using coins. Wood, fire starters, and misc. available at the campground for purchase. (\$34/ night).
Monday	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Mather Campground</u> at the Grand Canyon. Pay extra for showers using coins. Grocery store nearby with everything you could need. (\$18/night).
Tuesday	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Kanab Days Inn</u> (\$71) in Utah. It's 35 min from the Zion East Entrance. Cheap stay with breakfast and in town of Kanab.
Wednesday	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Motel 6 Page</u> in Arizona (\$101). Hotel located in the heart of page. Nice standard rooms for sleeping. No breakfast included. Restaurants, fast food, and groceries (Walmart) within 5/10 min radius.
Thursday	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Fort Tuthill Campground</u> in Flagstaff, Arizona. Wood and ice available for purchase at the campground. Can get cold and wet at night. Be prepared! (\$39/night) 8 min from Walmart and fast food.



Notes

Costs can vary based on your wants/needs and time of year traveling. Hotels are cheaper in the winter/spring (March specifically). I included total estimated costs without the use of points. Sedona, Grand Canyon, and Zion are free after purchasing the \$80 National Park Pass- this pass will get you into national parks free for a year!
